


ST.ALKZ KIDZKWIZ

Be a church detective—so **LOOK CLOSELY** to score maximum points! **Top possible score is 50 points!!**

Score **one point** by finding each item—and score **two points** by answering the question linked to it! Bonus questions (**lots of points**) may not have answers that are easy to find—you need to ask someone if you don't know!!!



1. Find this **COAT OF ARMS** somewhere in the church. (1 point) (for an extra 2 points): What was the name of the Lady this coat of arms belonged to? **She founded this church in 912 A.D.**



2. Find this picture of a bearded man carrying a stone tablet with numbers on. (1 point) Can you find his name (look hard!) (2 points). **Bonus question:** what was carved by God on the TWO stone tablets this man found? (3 points)



3. Score **two points** for every **dove** you can find in the church. Pictures in books—or that you have drawn yourself—don't count!!! **The dove represents the Holy Spirit.**



4. Find this **LAMB** somewhere in the church. (1 point) The lamb represents Jesus, and this carving is on the **FONT**. **Bonus question:** what is the **FONT** used for in church services? (two points)



5. The wooden seats in a church are called **PEWS**. In St Alkmund's the pews have numbers on each end of each pew. **What is the largest pew number you can find?** (1 point)

6. **One point each** for finding the triangle with Greek letters in and the golden cup with letters on (pictured on the right). **Who painted the cup?** (his surname is hidden in the painting)! (2 points)



7. **One point** for finding the **ALL-SEEING EYE**. You should find this easy! **It represents God.** **Two points** for finding what date the **WOODEN FONT COVER** was made—you may need help to climb the steps and have a peep at the top!!



8. **One point** if you find this little plaque with the picture of Jesus carrying the Cross. **How many other square plaques (the same shape) are on the walls?** (2 points)



9. The brass figure here is found on the south wall of the church. How many brass figures in total are there? (1 point) **This brass was stolen from the church** in about 1793. What year was it found and given back to St Alkmund's? (2 points)
